Welcome, Introductions, Agenda Review, Zoom Platform Overview

Herb Smart (Turlock Irrigation District) provided background information on SGMA, the East Turlock and West Turlock GSAs, and their combined approach to the GSP. He also shared his screen and demonstrated how to access events in the Turlock Groundwater website's calendar and where to view the Draft GSP Chapters.

Review of Draft Chapters 6 and 7: SMCs and Monitoring Networks

Karen Morgan with the City of Ceres provided a presentation of the Turlock GSP's approach to setting Sustainable Management Criteria and establishing Monitoring Networks.

Facilitated Question and Answer Session

The Facilitators engaged the audience to answer their questions. Allison Boucher from the Tuolumne River Conservancy asked where monitoring wells will be installed along the Tuolumne River. Karen Morgan replied that the locations have not been identified yet and noted that Turlock will supplement their data gaps with information. She volunteered to share the locations of the wells with Allison once they are selected. Allison clarified that the Conservancy is specifically interested in the first 10 miles of the River, below La Grange, as it may be a spawning location. Sarah Woolf and Matt Beaman offered their thoughts on finalizing GSPs and moving toward adoption.

Herb Smart thanked the attendees and provided a link to the Turlock Groundwater website. He provided information about how comments on the draft chapters can be submitted.
