PUBLIC WORKSHOPS SET FOR MAY 31 TO DISCUSS GROUNDWATER

Identical morning and evening presentations to update region on SGMA compliance efforts

DENAIR, CA – The Turlock Groundwater Basin Association (TGBA) is hosting two workshops on Wednesday, May 31, 2017, to update local stakeholders on implementation of the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) within the Turlock Subbasin. This event is open to the public and attendance is encouraged.

Both workshops will be held at the Denair Community Center, located at 3850 N. Gratton Road in Denair. Workshops will begin at 10 a.m. and 6 p.m., and are expected to last no more than two hours each. Both workshops will follow the same agenda and feature identical presentations; the public is encouraged to attend the session that is most convenient.

The workshops will cover a number of topics, including an update regarding local Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) formation activities to date and ways in which stakeholders can remain engaged and informed related to future groundwater management decisions. There will also be an open question and answer discussion at the end of the workshop. Informational material will be available for interested parties.

The Turlock Groundwater Basin Association (TGBA) was initially formed in 1995 by a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to provide a forum for local agencies to work together and to develop an initial Basin-wide Groundwater Management Plan (Plan) for the Turlock Groundwater Basin (or Subbasin). The initial plan, developed to comply with AB 3030 legislation, was adopted by local agencies in 1997. The formal MOU terminated on its own terms in December 1997.
