- 1) **CALL TO ORDER** – The meeting was called to order at 3:05 p.m. Michael Cooke, WTS TAC Chair.
- 2) **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION** – There was none.
- 3) **GROUNDWATER REGULATION COMPLIANCE WORKSHOP**  
Parry Klassen, Executive Director of the East San Joaquin Water Quality Coalition, lead a workshop on regulatory requirements being considered by the Regional Water Quality Control Board concerning salt and nitrate discharges into groundwater basins in the Central Valley of California. Speakers included Mr. Klassen, Tim Moore, Principal, Risk Sciences, Richard Meyerhoff, GEI Consultants, Inc., and Tess Dunham, Legal Counsel at Somach Simmons & Dunn, Attorneys at Law. Topics included regulatory requirements governing the discharge of nitrate and salt to the Turlock Groundwater basin and new permitting options; salinity control program for the Central Valley; and nitrate compliance through management zones. The TAC did not take action.
